INTRODUCTION

TOOLS:

• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)


Step 1 — Hard Drive



• Make sure the laptop is turned off, and the power cable is removed.


Leaving the laptop turned on can cause damage to the hardware and any stored data.

Step 2



- Turn the laptop over to access the backside of the computer.
- Identify and confirm that the laptop is an HP Pavilion x360 11-p110nr.
- Remove the nine screws from the back panel using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.

Step 3



- Remove the four screws holding in the hard drive compartment using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.
- Pull the hard drive up and out to remove it from the compartment.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
