



Dual-sided Vanity Mirror Cover Replacement

Fix a broken vanity mirror by replacing the mirror piece with a new one.

INTRODUCTION

If the mirror of the dual-sided magnifying vanity has broken, it can be easily replaced with a new piece. This prevents having to throw the whole mirror away, which saves money and prevents waste. Use this guide to remove the broken mirror cover and replace it with a new one.



TOOLS:

- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — mirror cover



- Measure the length of the mirror for purchasing a new replacement part.

Step 2



- Using the Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the screw on the side of the mirror.
- ⓘ The screws are very small and can be easily lost. Be aware while loosening them.

Step 3




- Remove the other screw from the opposite side of the mirror.

Step 4



- Lift off the mirror piece by pulling up at the sides.

 Tilt the mirror upward.

Step 5



- Remove the bolt on the left side connecting the second mirror piece to the stand by twisting it counter-clockwise.

Step 6



- Remove the larger bolt on the opposite side by twisting it counter-clockwise.

Step 7



- Take off the mirror piece

To reassemble your mirror with a new mirror piece, follow these instructions in reverse order.
