INTRODUCTION

If the laptop is overheating, it is possible that your fan is malfunctioning or needs to be cleaned. To replace, a replacement must be purchased and installed, while cleaning does not require a new fan. Follow this guide to clean or replace your computer fan.

TOOLS:

Spudger (1)
Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
Tweezers (1)
Canned Air (1)

Step 1 — Fan



• Locate the fan on the underside of the laptop.

Step 2



 Using a Phillips #1 screwdriver, remove the 4.5 mm screw securing the fan cover to the device.

Step 3



- Use a plastic spudger tool to free the cover.
- ⚠ The fan cover is extremely fragile and easy to break. Use caution during this step.

Step 4







- Lift the fan up from the device.
- *i* If you're cleaning the fan, stop at this step, and remove any build up. This can be done with <u>tweezers</u> and canned air.
- Disconnect the fan cable to fully remove the fan from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
