## Step 1 — Locating the filter





The cabin air filter is located in the passenger side footwell

#### Step 2 — Removing the cover







- Remove the cover by loosening the four screws that hold it in place, keeping track of where they
  go to replace them in the some holes.
- Once that the screws are removed, the cover will come down.

#### Step 3 — Removing the filter







- Now with more room to remove it, slide the two plastic tabs together.
- When the two plastic tabs are in the middle pull the filter cover down.

#### Step 4 — Removing the filter II





- Remove the filter.
- Once you remove the filter make sure to notice the direction of the air-flow arrows so that you
  install the new one in the same direction.

### Step 5 — Re-assembly



- To install the new filter follow the previous steps in reverse. If the filter and the plastic cover don't install fully, it is possible that it is installed backwards.
- When re-installing the cover re-insert the tab and push upwards. Then reinstall the screws.
