

# Zenithink ZTPAD ZT280 C91 Back Panel Replacement

This guide shows how to remove the back panel of the device to access all of the electronics inside.

## INTRODUCTION

Before you begin this guide, make sure to have the proper tools. You will need a spudger, and a phillips head #00 screwdriver. If you're having trouble with the battery in your device, removing the back panel is one of the first steps in replacing the battery.

## **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

#### Step 1 — Back Panel



- Remove the two screws on the bottom using a Phillips #00 screwdriver.
- *i* For differentiation purposes, these screws are 4mm long.

#### Step 2



- Using a spudger, start prying the case apart by working around the edge slowly.
- Be careful not to damage any of the latches that hold the back panel in place, especially if you are using a metal spudger.
- (i) While prying, be careful to not lose the power and volume buttons; the case is the only thing holding them in place so they will easily come out once the panel has been removed

A Be careful to not damage the speaker cables, they will still be connecting both panels.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
