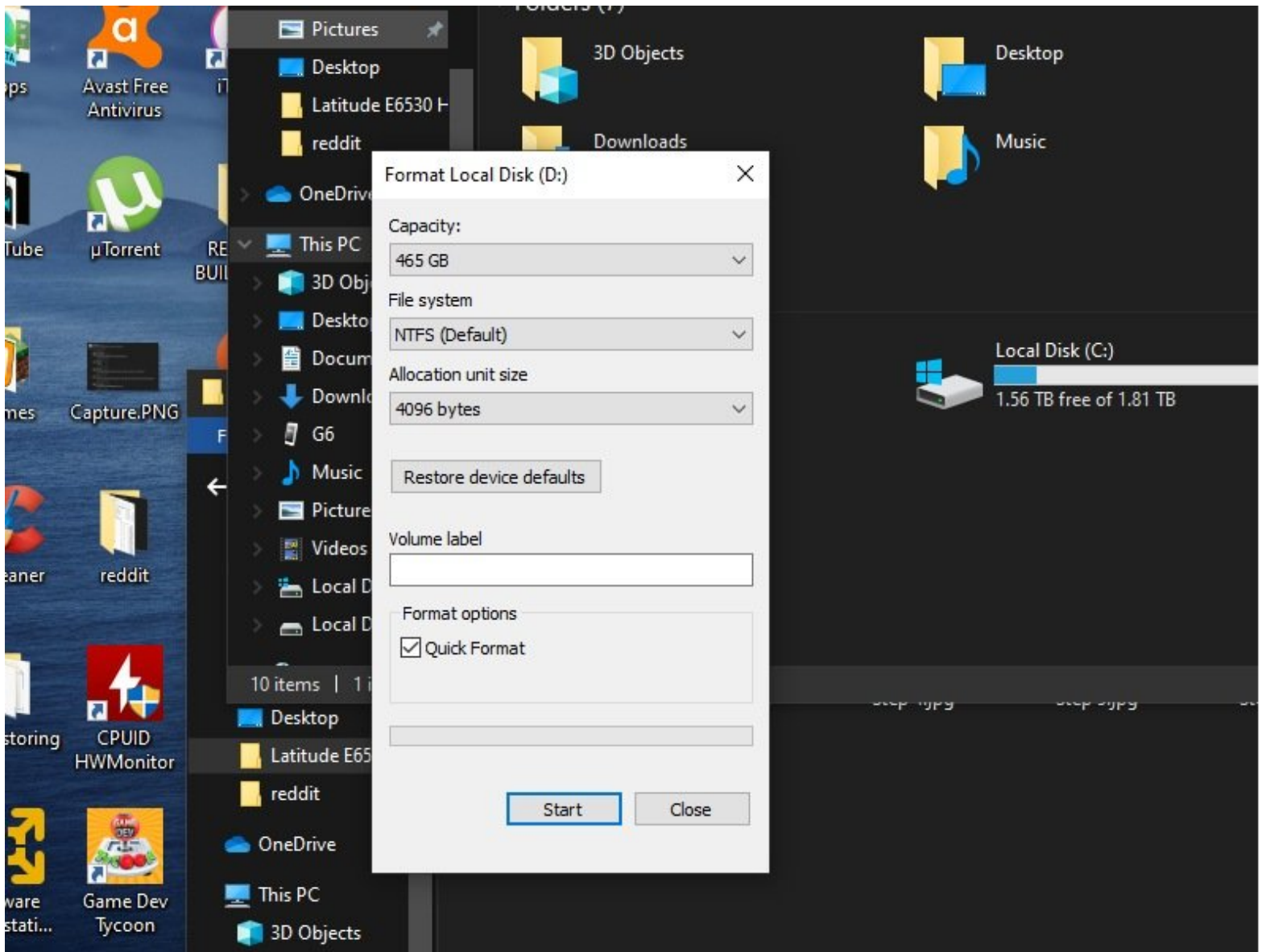

# INTRODUCTION

This tutorial will help you to replace/upgrade the HDD/SSD in your Dell Latitude E6530 laptop



## TOOLS:

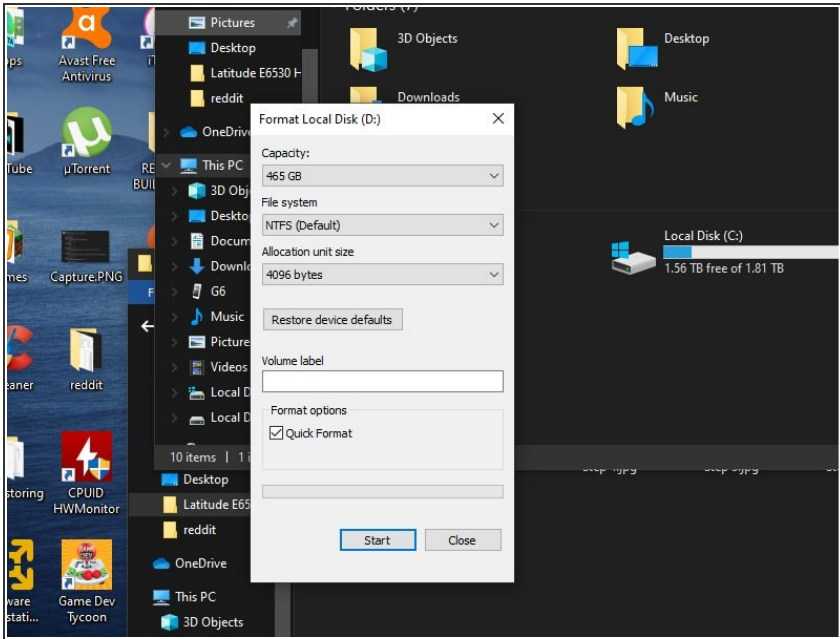
- [Phillips #1 Screwdriver](#) (1)



## PARTS:

- [1 TB SSD](#) (1)
- [250 GB SSD](#) (1)
- [Crucial MX500 500 GB SSD](#) (1)
- [2 TB SSD](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Preparing



- If the new drive is used, be sure to format it!

## Step 2



- Be sure to have a flash drive or DVD with your preferred OS on it.

### Step 3



- Power off the laptop and remove the AC adapter.

### Step 4 — Battery



- Pull back the battery tabs



## Step 5



- Pull out the battery

## Step 6 — Drive



- Unscrew the 2 Phillips #1 screws holding the drive in.
- ☑ Keep the screws somewhere you won't lose them.

## Step 7



- Pull out the drive

## Step 8



- Undo the Phillips #1 screw keeping the drive in the bracket.

## Step 9



- Pull out the drive

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
