


Zoll Impact Uni-Vent 731 Battery Compartment Replacement

This guide will show users how to take apart the battery compartment kit in the Zoll Impact Uni-Vent 731.

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INTRODUCTION

The following guide will provide instructions on how to replace the battery compartment of the ventilator. This is a useful guide if there are any damages to the battery compartment case and it needs to be replaced. For more information on replacing the battery compartment, please refer to **page 25** of the service manual.


Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)




PARTS:


- Battery Compartment Case with Gaskets
 (1)
- Screw, Phillips, Pan Head, SS, 6-32 X 5/16 (4)

Step 1 — Battery Compartment Kit



- Remove the battery compartment cover by unscrewing the (4) Phillips 6-32 X 5/16 screws. This is indicated in red with the number 1.
- Page 25.







- Remove the battery by unscrewing the (4)Phillips 6-32 X 2 ¼ screws and detaching the plug from its locking latch. This is indicated in the second picture in blue with the number 2.
- Page 25.




- Unscrew the (4) 6-32 X 5/16 Phillips screws to remove the damaged battery compartment case.
- Page 25.



- Rotate battery compartment to mate with upper and lower case cutouts and press firmly into place. Secure with (4) Phillips 6-32 X 5/16 screws provided.
- Page 25.



- Re-assemble the battery by connecting its cable to the connector (pull on cable to insure it is locked in place) then tightening the (4) Phillips 6-32 X 2 ¼ screws. This is indicated in blue with the number 5.
- Page 25.



- Re-assemble the battery compartment cover by tightening the (4) 6-32 X5/16 screws. This is indicated in red with the number 6.
- Page 25.



- Perform HiPot Testing then perform Functional Test using the RCS to verify the replacement is working properly.
- Page 25.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
