INTRODUCTION

This guide replaces the USB port for the Lenovo Legion Y530-15ICH, overtime with use it make break/get water damaged. This is especially important if the user needs to connect a smartphone.

Step 1 — Back Cover



 **Ensure the device is powered off.**


- Use a PZ00 screwdriver bit to remove the eleven screws securing the back cover.
 - Five 7 mm screws
 - Six 4 mm screws

Step 2




- Carefully pry the back cover off the computer using an opening pick.
 - ① Start at the corner of the laptop and work your way around the side. Gently pull up on the cover until it detaches.

Step 3 — USB Port



- Remove the ribbon cable connecting the USB port to the motherboard, located adjacent to the fan unit.
- Using a JIS #1 screwdriver, remove the two screws securing the USB port to the module.

Step 4



- Gently disconnect the single ribbon cable with your fingers.
- Remove the USB port from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
