



How to Replace a Coffee Tabletop Glass

INTRODUCTION

Exposure to high temperatures or to very cold/ hot items may lead to damage or shatter the table top a coffee table.

Fortunately, you can easily replace only the glass of table instead of buying a brand new coffee table, by consequently reducing costs and also waste.

This guide intends to guide you on how to safely replace the glass of a coffee tabletop.

TOOLS:

Cleaning Spray (1)

Nitrile Gloves 100 Box (1)

Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Coffee Table Glass




- Flip the coffee table base upside down on an empty area.

Step 2



- Use a cleaning spray to clean the surface of the glass table.

 Use gloves while cleaning the table.
The glass cleaner spray may contain toxic chemicals.

Step 3



- Use a Phillips #2 screwdriver to remove one 1/4 in.-20 x 1-1/2 in. socket cap screw from the side of the glass.
 - Repeat the process for the other 1/4 in.-20 x 1-1/2 in. socket cap screw.
- i** The appearance of this screw may differ from table to table, but the procedure remains the same. Use the appropriate screwdriver to open the screws.

Step 4



- Remove the coffee table legs piece by piece.

Step 5



- Remove the glass.

⚠ Remember that glass can be shattered or partially damaged. Use gloves to avoid possible cuts.

Step 6



- Replace the broken/ damaged glass with the new one.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
