



# EVGA GeForce GTX 1080 FTW2 DT GAMING with iCX Cooler PCIe Mounting plate Removal

How to remove the PCIe Slot Mounting plate from the EVGA GeForce GTX 1080 FTW2 DT  
GAMING video card

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 **TOOLS:**


- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- 5mm Allen Hex Socket (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

## Step 1 — Remove Dust Caps



- If you have any dust caps over the HDMI or Display Port connections, remove them

## Step 2 — Remove Back Screws



- Remove the 3 screws using a Phillips #1 Screwdriver (Red)
- Remove the 2 Standoffs using a 5mm socket

### Step 3



- Remove top screw using a Phillips #0 screwdriver (Blue)
- Remove the bottom screw and nut using a Phillips #0 screwdriver. Will want to use a finger to hold the nut from spinning while releasing the screw.

### Step 4 — Slide out the plate



- Gently slide the plate out from between the back cover and the circuit board. It should come out without much force.
- If it doesn't want to budge, check that the right screw was removed from the top of the video card.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
