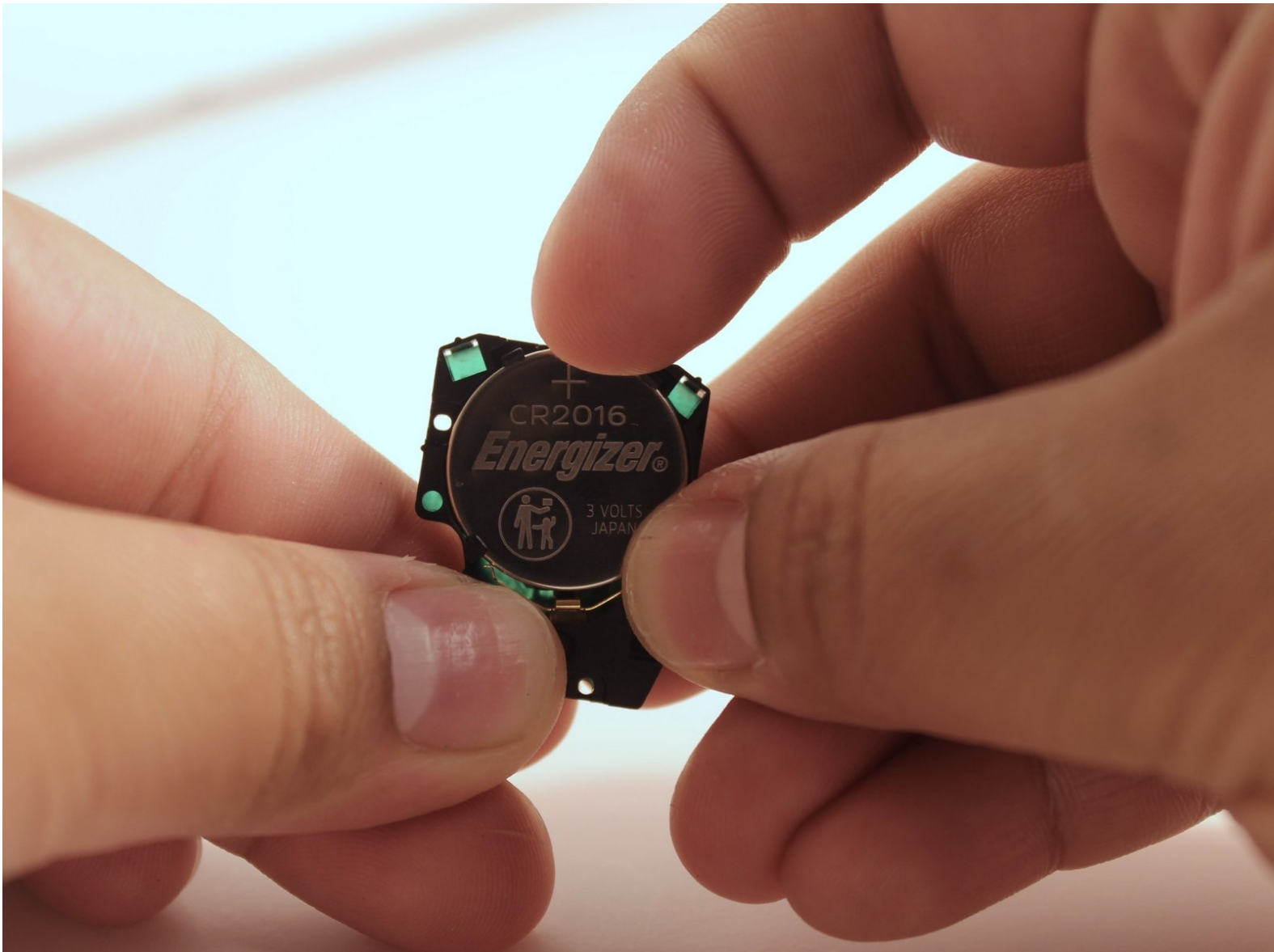




2016 Toyota Camry Key Fob Battery Replacement

This guide will help replace the battery on a 2016 Toyota Camry Key fob.

INTRODUCTION

This guide demonstrates how to replace the battery in a 2016 Toyota Camry key fob.

Key fobs conveniently unlock and lock your vehicle from a distance with the click of a button. Unfortunately, after 3 or 4 years of continuous use, the battery drains and needs to be replaced.


This is a fairly simple fix that can be completed at home with nothing more than a coin!

Step 1 — Key Fob Battery



- Take a coin and wedge it between both halves of the key fob where the keychain notch is. Push against the indent until the fob begins to lift open.

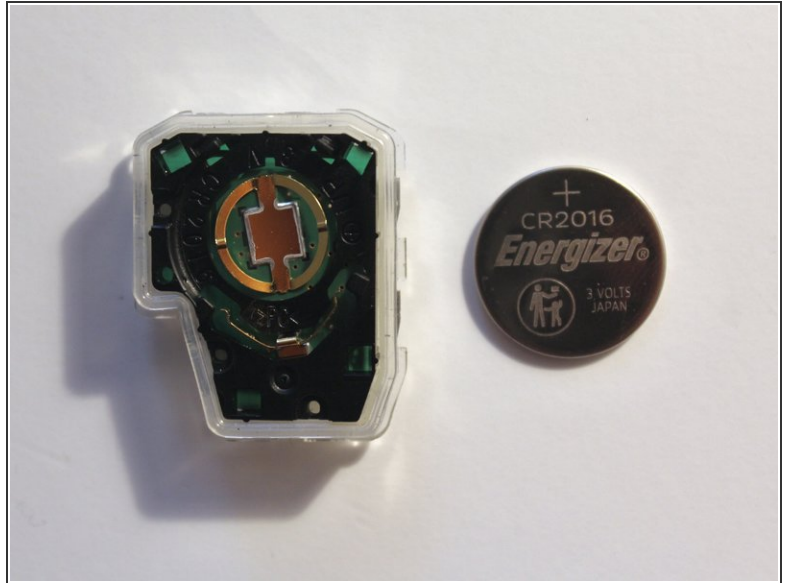
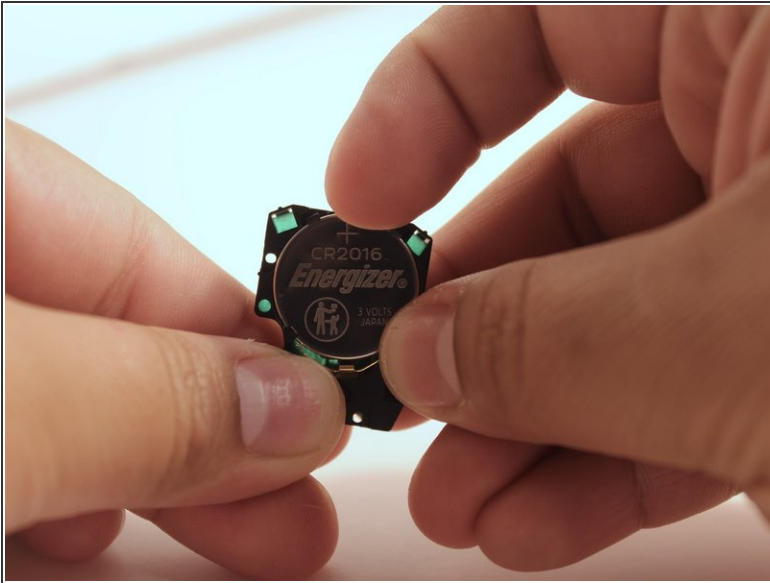
 Take care not to lose the buttons, as they may fall out.

Step 2



- Look for the notch where it says “use coin to open.” Push against the indent with your coin to separate the pieces.
- Remove the middle console.

Step 3



- Use your fingernail to pry around the battery until it pops out.
- ☑ When inserting the new battery, make sure that the positive side is facing up.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
