Access the speaker case's internals by removing the electronics box attached to the back panel.

INTRODUCTION

Your B212D contains a case filled with a metal box that contains all the electronics, except for the speakers. You will be removing this electronics box to access the case's internal space - you know, in case you need to stash \$1,000,000 dollars in there to hide it from the CIA! :)



TOOLS:

Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Removing the Behringer Eurolive B212D Electronics Box



- ↑ CAUTION: Unplug your speaker from the power outlet.
 - Remove the 8 Phillips screws from the back of the speaker.

Step 2



- Carefully remove the back panel, lifting out the metal electronics-box with it.
- To avoid damaging your speaker, remove slowly, as there is still a wire attached from the electronics box to the speaker.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
