


# Lenovo Y50-70 Touch Heat Sink Replacement

This guide will demonstrate how to properly and safely replace the heat sink.




## INTRODUCTION

The heat sink transfers excess thermal energy away from the CPU to the fan and cooling system in order to protect the CPU's delicate components.


TOOLS:	DARTS:
<ul> <li>Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Lenovo Y50-70 Heat Sink (1)</li> </ul>

#### Step 1 — Heat Sink



- Remove all twelve 6 mm long screws on the back of the laptop with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.
  - (i) Apply a lot of pressure to prevent the screws from stripping.
  - Make sure to turn off the computer first!

## Step 2




• Pull off the back cover of the laptop. It should come off easily.

## Step 3



• Remove all six 7mm screws from the heat sink using the Phillips #1 screwdriver.

## Step 4



- Remove the heat sink.
- Take note of the gray thermal paste on the back of the heat sink.
  - Refer to the <u>iFixit Applying Thermal Paste Guide</u> when replacing your heat sink.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
