


Acer Iconia One 7 Speaker Replacement

This guide will instruct users how to replace the speaker area of the Acer Iconia One 7.

INTRODUCTION

The speaker is an essential part of the Acer Iconia One 7 enabling it to give auditory notifications and playback to the users. The speaker appears sturdy but it is in fact a delicate part requiring careful attention to detail and a light touch during replacement.



TOOLS:

- Tweezers (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- JIS #00 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Speaker



- Begin at any side of the tablet.
- With a plastic opening tool, begin taking apart the back cover from the tablet by working along the edges.
- Prying the lid open can be difficult; use caution in order to safely remove.
- (i) Turn off device before this step.

Step 2



- Using a plastic opening tool, separate the back cover from the main device.
- Open each side continuously to ensure all sides have been separated.


Step 3



- Turn the tablet over to locate the speaker.
- ⚠ Besides the parts that are mentioned in the instruction, try not to agitate other fragile components inside the device.
 - The speaker is on the bottom of the inside.


Step 4





- Peel back tape.
- Using tweezers, detach connection from motherboard.

Step 5







- Unscrew screws with a JIS screwdriver with a #00 screw bit.
- Dislodge the speaker unit.
- ↑ Take care not to displace any other bits in the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
