

# **Toshiba Excite 7c Motherboard Replacement**

This guide will show you how to replace the motherboard in a Toshiba Excite 7c tablet.

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#### **INTRODUCTION**


This guide will show you how to replace the motherboard in your Toshiba Excite 7c tablet. Replacing the motherboard is a last resort to fix a malfunctioning device. Unless there is visible damage to the motherboard, your problem may be caused by something else. Before beginning the repair make sure you have exhausted other troubleshooting options.



### **TOOLS:**

- Tweezers (1)
- iFixit Opening Tool (1)
- Minnow Driver Kit (1)

### Step 1 — Motherboard



- Place an iFixit opening tool in the seam between the screen and back casing.
- Apply pressure down all four sides to separate the back casing from the screen.
- Place the tablet face down and carefully remove the back panel.

## Step 2





- Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the five 6 mm screws from the motherboard.
- Use tweezers to gently disconnect the two ribbon cables.
- Pull straight up to remove the board.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
