TOOLS:

Phillips Head Screwdriver: Size PH1 (1)

PARTS:


Acer 3ICP4/68/111, AP16A4K 11.25V 3770mAh (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Remove eleven 4 mm Phillips #1 screws.
- Pull the backplate off using your fingers.

Step 2



- Pull the rainbow cord out of the motherboard using the tabs on the sides.

Step 3



- Remove three 3 mm Phillips #1 screws holding down the battery.
- Lift the top edge of the battery and pull back towards the hinges to remove the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
